Classroom Release Time (CRT)

Rationale:

Address teacher workload while maximising benefits for student learning.

Purpose:

- enhances the school's teaching and learning programmes
- the teacher's professional growth
- the learning needs of the students

Guidelines:

- 1. Fulltime teachers only are entitled to classroom release time as stated in the current Primary Teachers Collective Agreement.
- 2. Each fulltime classroom teacher (or fulltime relieving teacher for a term or more) employed for at least .8 of a week, is provided with the equivalent of ten hours classroom release time per term.
- 3. The use of CRT should normally be consistent across all classroom teachers.
- 4. The method of allocation for CRT should be reviewed regularly by Senior management and may vary depending on the identified need of the school.
- 5. Release time generated through entitlement and additional responsibilities or management, should be kept separate as much as possible.
- 6. CRT is not normally cumulative, however where for genuine reasons, it is not possible to provide CRT to an individual, the school will record the reason for non-delivery and/or reallocate the CRT at a later date, preferably in the same school year.
