Uniform Policy

Rationale:


Having a uniform fosters pride and self esteem in students, promotes the culture of the School and visibility in the community.

Purpose

- To enhance the identity of Hauraki School students.
- To ensure clarity of standards for wearing the uniform.

Guidelines:

- 1) The current Hauraki School uniform requirements are set out in Appendix 1. This will allow the current Board to add or make changes regarding uniform.
- 2) The wearing of the uniform at school is compulsory for all students.
- 3) The uniform is to be worn in its entirety and must be in good condition and clearly named.
- 4) Uniform can be purchased at anytime from the school office
- 5) Hats are compulsory during Terms 1 and 4 only.
- 6) Students are required to wear the uniform at special school events outside school hours.
- 7) Full payment must be made at the time of purchase but support for those parents with genuine hardship are to be referred to the Principal.
