Minutes of Previous Meetings:

Resolved that the minutes of the meeting held 26 June 2023 are approved.

Financial Report (including Property):

The Board noted the June 2023 financial report and discussed the Musac overspend compared to budget (which was not a major concern).

Principal's Report (including Annual Plan):

The Principal spoke to the report, noting:

- the ongoing focus on structured literacy;
- the recent conference (based on Reggio Emilia) hosted at Hauraki was very successful and likely to be repeated in October;
- Hauraki placed first and second in the book club competition hosted at Northcross last week:
- Hauraki successfully retained the Brad Johnstone shield in its rugby fixture against Belmont on Wednesday;
- the local histories curriculum has been successfully implemented;
- Brain Play has provided robotics and digital sessions;
- the local hui (held triennially) was well attended and ideas successfully exchanged to develop action plans. Clarinda is hoping to arrange a hangi for later in the year;
- the Hauraki School Facebook Page has been reinvigorated and will be managed in line with IT policies and privacy considerations; and
- new board reporting regulations are expected to capture current planning and strategy documentation and will be considered further prior to implementation of the regulations (in 2024) as needed.

The Board resolved to approve the Policy.

A lockdown drill was successfully completed (following recent incidents in the wider Auckland region) and will be reported in an upcoming newsletter. The Board noted all government-imposed Covid restrictions have now been removed (as of midnight).
