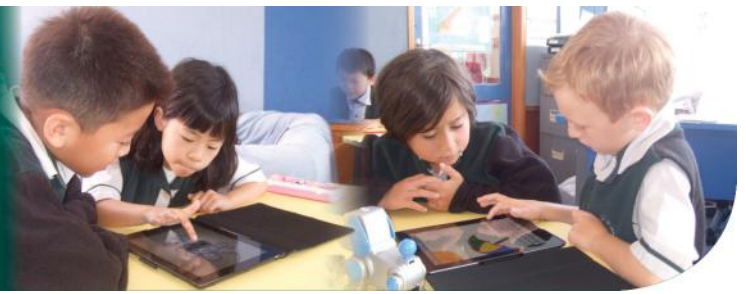

#### What's Kindo?

It's an online ordering system that allows you to pay the PTA and others directly, without sending cash to school.

#### Will I be able to pay School Donations and Activity Fees with it?

No. Hauraki School will be adopting an online payment system in future. You'll hear more about it closer to the time.

#### What sort of things can I buy with Kindo?

PTA activities like sausage sizzles, Hauraki Hunt, Disco, Quiz Night, Twilight Fair... and more!  
You can also order Pita Pit, MyDeli, and perhaps more in future.... watch this space!

#### I have a Kindo account for Belmont Intermediate or Takapuna Grammar, do I need another account?

No, just log in to your existing account and add your children under Hauraki School. You'll be able to do all of your lunch ordering and admin in a single place.

#### How do I pay?

You can add credit by credit card or online banking, or you can top up your balance at checkout when you buy.

#### How do I sign up?

#### How do I buy Hauraki Hunt tickets?

Log in and set up your children.

You'll need to buy a ticket for each adult and child (over 5) in your team.

If you want to be in a team with people from another family, just agree a team name and when each family buys their tickets, add your team name and we'll match you up. Easy as!
