Dear Parents/Caregivers

Welcome to term 3! I hope you all managed some quality time with your tamariki and everyone is feeling ready for another busy term of learning. 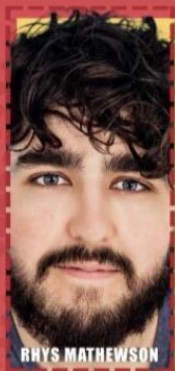

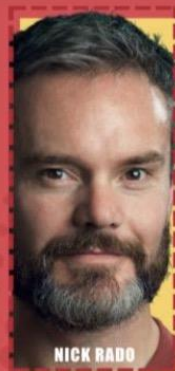
