SCHOOL SHOW

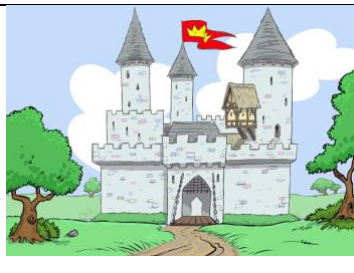
Please be aware that our school show *What A Knight* is to be performed by year 5 and 6 students in September on the following dates:

REMINDERS
