Dear Parents/Caregivers

I was delighted to receive earlier this week our latest Education Review Office report. It was very positive in all respects. They were impressed with all our efforts in recent years and the way we had built on our favourable 2011 report. A few excerpts follow. *'The school provides students with a relevant, responsive curriculum that is highly effective in promoting and supporting student engagement in learning. Teaching and learning supports students to be independent, self-managing learners'*. Also *'the school is very well placed to sustain and improve its performance. High quality self review is a feature of school operations and is used well to improve outcomes for students'*. They concluded by saying, *'Students at Hauraki School experience high quality education. They engage purposefully in learning and benefit from a broad curriculum. High expectations support students to experience success as learners. School governance and leadership is effective and parent partnerships in learning are valued. These features contribute positively to students' well being and learning'*.

SICKNESS

Please when your child is unwell the expectation is that you keep them at home until they are completely better. This is for the benefit of everyone! We understand that sometimes parents are under pressure with work commitments and/or do not believe their child is that unwell, but we cannot have sick children at school. It is unfair on the child concerned and bugs readily spread from one to another to include teachers which results in lots of sick people. On several occasions recently we have had to send the same child home two or three times over a two or three day period because they have been sent back to school not 100%. If vomiting or diarrhoea is involved the 'Guidelines for the Control of Infection and Communicable Disease in School' state that they should not return for 48 hours. Thank you for your understanding.

Thank you to everyone who came and supported this event. The weather was challenging but in the end children competed enthusiastically with many great results as follows:

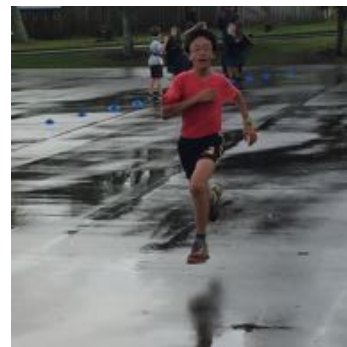
